PROGRAM: Cosmetology
COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Students will be introduced to the field of Cosmetology. Topics to be covered in the course will include Hair Color Theory and Techniques, Facials and Makeup Applications, Manicuring, Pedicuring and the application of Artificial Nails.. This is the introduction of the Credit Hour Cosmetology course students must take to be eligible to take the State Board of Cosmetology exam to become a licensed Cosmetologist. It is a yearlong course. Biology is a suggested prerequisite.
